HONOLULU – An O‘ahu jury found Isaiah McCoy, 31, guilty as charged yesterday on one count of Robbery in the Second Degree relating to a 2019 robbery in Waikiki. He faces 10 years behind bars for the crime.

McCoy and an accomplice brutally beat the victim and stole his watch as he stood outside a Kuhio Avenue bar. The victim suffered numerous injuries as a result of the robbery.

“The members of the jury deserve the gratitude of our community,” said Prosecuting Attorney Steve Alm. “This verdict sends a strong message that crimes like the one committed by McCoy will not be tolerated in Honolulu,” he continued. “Because of the seriousness of this crime and the need to deter future criminal conduct, we will be seeking the maximum prison term for McCoy at sentencing,” he said.

McCoy’s sentencing is set for July 27, 2021.

The case was prosecuted by Felony Prosecution Division Team Captain David Van Acker.
