## For Immediate Release July 21, 2021

HONOLULU – Yesterday an O'ahu jury found Nathan Matthew Reed, 41, guilty as charged on two counts of Attempted Sexual Assault in the First Degree and one count of Burglary in the First Degree. Reed entered the victim's Waikiki apartment and attempted to sexually assault her. The victim was able to break free and alert a Honolulu Police Department officer outside the building.

Reed faces up to 20 years in prison on each count of Attempted Sexual Assault in the First Degree and up to 10 years in prison on the count of Burglary in the First Degree.

"The Department of the Prosecuting Attorney is very pleased with this verdict and will ask the court to impose the maximum prison term for Reed," said Prosecuting Attorney Steve Alm. "That is the only way to ensure that the public is kept safe from Reed's violent and dangerous behavior," he continued. "I thank the jury for its service and the Honolulu Police Department for its investigation of this case," he said.

Reed's sentencing is set for October 19, 2021.

The case was prosecuted by Victoria M. Chang, a member of the Department's Sex Assault Team.
